When you fill out your homework chart indicate if you read the text plus completed the sheet. You will discover that some parts of the book are even easy to read.

As you can see from the chart, you first were assigned chapters 1-5 and now chapters 7-15. We always skip chapter 6, as it is unnecessary to the plot.
